Revised Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF)

BAF notice ex China / Japan / Korea / Taiwan to Australia 24 December 2011

Reflecting the recent increase in the process of oil at Hong Kong and South Korea, the member lines of AADA* wish to advise that in accordance with the established review procedures, the Bunker Surcharge level for shipments from Japan, Korea, China, Hong Kong and Taiwan to ports in Australia is to be adjusted to USD 625.00 per TEU and USD 1,250.00 per FEU for dry and refrigerated containers with effect from 24 December 2011 (Bill of Lading Date).

Revised Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF) ex China / Japan / Korea / Taiwan USD625 / TEU – Effective 24 December 2011 (B/L Date)

This revised Bunker Adjustment Factor is out of the direct control of Toll Global Forwarding.
