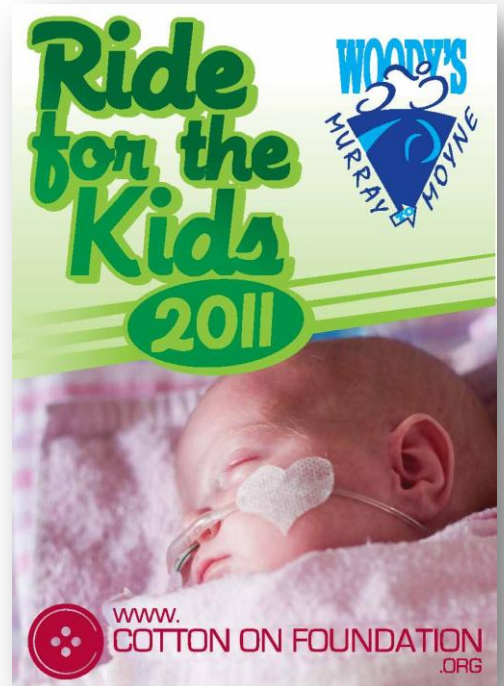


Toll Global Forwarding Supports The Cotton On Group's, Ride for the Kids!

Currently in its 26th year the annual Murray to Moyne is a challenging 520km, 24 hour cycle relay from Echuca on the Murray River to Port Fairy on the Moyne River.

From humble beginnings, the Ride, which is now dedicated to the late Graham 'Woody' Woodrup, raised \$1,300,000 in 2011. It is tasked with the dual goals of raising funds for Hospitals and Health Services throughout Victoria and to convey *Woodys'* mission of extolling the health and social benefits of cycling.

In 2011, Cotton On entered a team of 12 riders, broken into three groups of four riders, with each group undertaking 30km rotations. The team left at 8.30am on Saturday and arrived in Port Fairy at 11.30am on Sunday with the night spent in Hamilton. The team dedicated their efforts to the Geelong Hospital's Children's Wing development fund, raising \$17,000.
